CLINICAL FOCUS OF THIS SESSION

This session reframes deep caries management as a structured decision-making process rather than a purely procedural one, integrating clinical judgement with child-centred care.

By the end of this lecture, participants will be able to:

1. Identify when deep caries in primary teeth needs pulpal management beyond a filling.
2. Distinguish which pulp treatment is appropriate for each case
3. Communicate risks, benefits, alternatives and outcomes to parents.
4. Apply effective behaviour management and local anaesthesia techniques to improve treatment acceptance
5. Recognise when treatment can be done chairside versus referral to optimise care and reduce risks.
