The benefits of digital dentures include greater accuracy and fit due to precision in digital impressions, improved patient comfort, fewer appointments required, consistent and reproducible results and easy remakes if dentures are lost.

Dr. Khng is a Board-Certified Prosthodontist both in the United States of America and in Singapore. He is a past-president of the Prosthodontic Society of Singapore, a Fellow of the American College of Prosthodontist, Fellow of the Academy of Medicine of Singapore, member of the Singapore Dental Association and a member of the American Prosthodontic Society.

Dr. Khng is also an instructor for the suction effective mandibular complete denture (SEMCD) technique, and lectures and gives hands-on courses to dentists around the region.
