COURSE OVERVIEW

This one-day course provides a practical approach to achieving invisible anterior direct composite restorations. During the morning lecture session, participants will learn how to collect and interpret clinical information, analyze tooth color and optical characteristics, and understand modern composite shade systems through a variety of clinical cases. The lecture will focus on predictable shade selection and the relationship between color, morphology, and light. In the afternoon hands-on session, participants will restore a Class IV anterior case using a universal composite restorative material. They will learn simplified shade selection, predictable layering techniques, and methods for recreating natural tooth morphology.

The goal of this course is not only to teach clinical techniques, but also to understand the decision making process behind predictable and natural-looking esthetic outcomes.

DR. YUKIHIRO KOSAKA (D.D.S., PH.D.)

Dr. Yukihiro Kosaka is a medical staff member in the Department of Molecular and Regenerative Prosthodontics at the Graduate School of Dentistry, Tohoku University in Japan. He completed his Doctor of Dental Surgery degree in 2014 and earned his Ph.D. from Tohoku University in 2020. Since 2021, Dr. Kosaka has been engaged in clinical practice and research in molecular and regenerative prosthodontics. His clinical and academic focus includes esthetic composite restorations, adhesive dentistry, and biomimetic restorative techniques. Dr. Kosaka is widely published and frequently invited to speak at international conferences including IDS Cologne, Japan Dental Show, and the Bio-Emulation Symposium. He is a member of the Bio-Emulation group and the Japan Prosthodontic Society.
